Monday	Pumpkin Characters Divide your classroom in 3 groups, provide each group with a pumpkin, art and craft materials, and recyclable materials to decorate (paper bags, bottle cups, color paper, yarn)	While they work on their creations ask, "Tell me what is <u>between</u> this and this? What did you put <u>above</u> the pumpkin? What color is that circle <u>next to</u> its mouth?" When they finish decorating, each group must place pumpkins in their favorite spot of the classroom. Encourage them to use spatial words while doing so!!!	Tuesday	Treasure Map Hide a little Halloween Treat. Draw a simple map of your classroom or the playground using 3 or four stops to help lead your children to a "treasure." Talk about why each symbol represents a location.	Make them go <u>under</u> , <u>over</u> , and <u>through</u> places to get to the treasure! After you finish the activity encourage them to talk about the experience. Ask questions like: "Where did you go? Did you find it <u>above</u> , <u>under</u> or <u>beside</u> the shelf?"


