SUBJECT: DIRECT THE SUPERINTENDENT TO PROVIDE REQUESTED INFORMATION

The following requests have been made to the Superintendent:

1. August 22, 2006 Time spent responding to Board Members' requests
2. November 7, 2006 Information relating to the expenditures of the Young Women's Academy and the Highland Oaks Middle Schools projects
3. October 2, 2006 Information relating to the Civilian Investigative Unit
4. October 2, 2006 Copy of the job description provided to Korn Ferry for the position of Inspector General
5. October 2, 2006 Information relating to MEP administrators pay grade 24 and above hired since May 2006
6. November 27, 2006 Information relating to overtime payments that have resulted in salaries of over \$100,000.

To date, the information has not been provided despite repeated efforts to obtain the information. This item requests that the School Board direct the Superintendent to comply with School Board Rule 6Gx13- 8C-1.20 by providing the requested information.

In the alternative, if the Board specifically disapproves of any of the requests because it believes the request would "entail a special study" then this item requests that the Board direct the Superintendent to provide the requested information as provided in Chapter 119 within a reasonable time not to exceed 10 days.
