The Miami-Association of Insurance and Financial Advisors (MAIFA) held its 2nd annual Charity Golf Tournament on April 21, 2006 at the Miami Springs Golf and Country Club. Proceeds of the tournament will benefit the Miami-Dade County Public Schools' Academy of Finance providing college scholarships to the students who are graduating and would otherwise be unable to attend a college of their choice.

This is MAIFA's third year working with the Academy of Finance. In 2005, fifteen Miami-Dade County Public School Academy of Finance students each received a \$500 scholarship. It is expected that the proceeds from the 2006 tournament will yield approximately 25 scholarships.
