SUBJECT: SUPERINTENDENT SHALL OVERSEE THAT THERE IS FULL COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIRED NUMBER OF FIRE DRILLS AND SHALL DEVELOP A MECHANISM TO INSURE THE SAME WITHIN ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS

In response to recent School Board member inquiries, the Superintendent of Schools directed staff to review the district's emergency drill standards. A new procedure was subsequently implemented to facilitate monthly monitoring of the required drills and to enable staff to verify full compliance with the requirement prior to the end of each school year.

The Department of Safety, Environment and Hazards Management will enforce ongoing compliance with the new procedure. Principals of schools where the required drills are not performed must provide written justification to their region superintendent.
