The mission of the Miami-Dade County School Board is to “support the improvement of student achievement, strengthening instructional leadership, by launching innovative systemic initiatives, and by disseminating resources that enhance curriculum and instruction.”

In accordance with this mission and to further enhance academic performance, this item aims to identify those curricular areas that may take time away from the teaching of basic skills, thereby impacting negatively on student performance. Student achievement must be the first priority of this Board. It is the Board's responsibility to allocate resources where they will do the most good. Therefore, the Board must identify and assess these programs and measure their effectiveness in the overall education of children.
